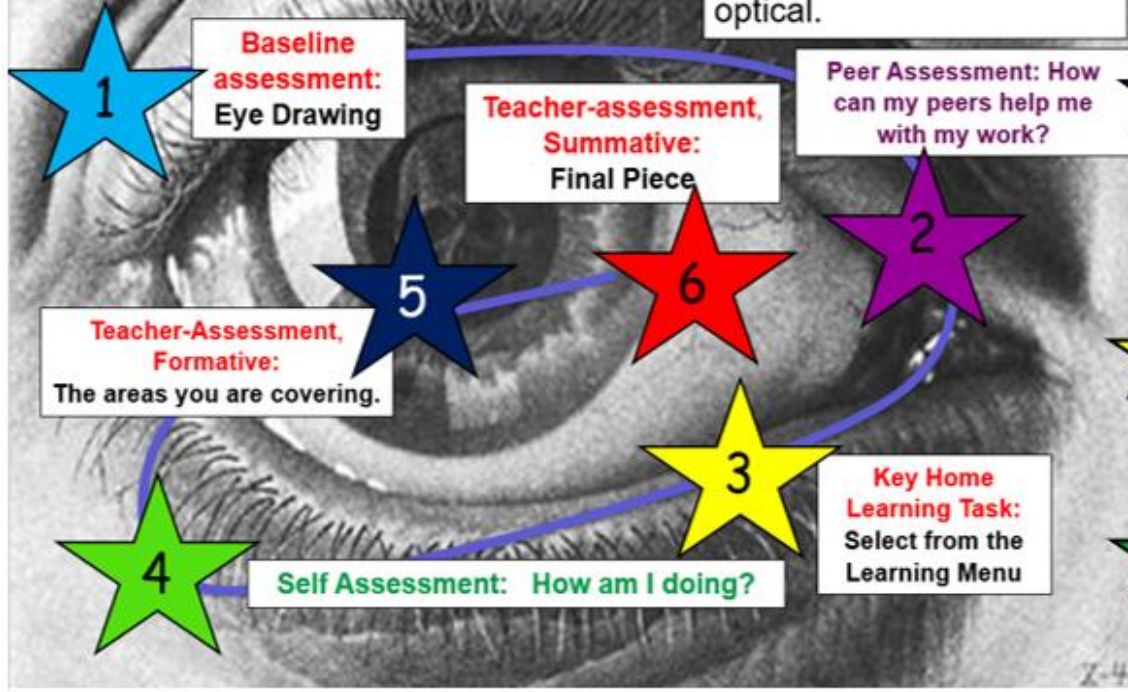


Year 9 – Optical Illusions
